From Steve's explanatory handout: The Chevy Volt has a unique feature that lends itself to acting as an emergency generator when grid power goes down. The main traction battery (300 volts) constantly charges a 12 volt start / accessory battery when the vehicle is turned on. This allows one to utilize the 12 volts output from this battery to an inverter for conversion to AC house current.

As long as the vehicle is turned on, the main traction battery will keep the 12 volt battery charged. If the traction battery is depleted below 15% SOC (state of charge), the engine automatically starts and begins recharging the battery, within the limits of the amp draw from the house. This will cycle several times until the engine runs out of fuel.

2025 Amateur Radio Examinations

In the Rogue Valley, amateur radio exams are provided by the RVARC and the SOARC. New exam participants need to provide identification, while upgrading amateurs need to **provide a copy of their current license** as well as show photo identification. **Applicants also need a Federal Registration Number (FRN) and email prior to taking the test.** The exam fee for 2024 remains \$15.00. All license candidates must provide a picture ID. Upgrading amateurs must also provide a photocopy of their current license to send in with their application.
