7:00 pm meeting opened by VP Allan Taylor, K7GT.

Presentation over Zoom by Mike Walker, VA3MW, on the Flex Radio Aurora 500 Watt Integrated SDR Transceiver. Due to the increase in noise floor in urban locations these days, higher power than the old 100W is now more useful. The new radio produces 500Watts, but is lighter, claimed to be 18 Lb, and more power efficient, at 80%, than older design 500W rigs.

Device overview from their website:

- 500W high-efficiency transmitter
- Integrated AC/DC power supply (80–264VAC input)
- Automatic antenna tuner
- SmartSignal™ adaptive predistortion for cleaner signals and reduced IMD
- Controlled Envelope SSB (CESSB): Up to 3 dB more talk power with no

Program: The free, open-source CHIRP radio programming software works on Windows, Macintosh, and Linux PCs. Kameron will discuss information about the application, how to configure it to connect to your radios, and how to program radio settings including cloning radio programming between devices.

Biography: Kameron Gasso, W7KRG has worked professionally in technology for over 25 years in roles including support, network and systems engineering, and IT operations management. He got his start in radio in the late 1980s and early 1990s with shortwave listening and CB, did some commercial VHF/UHF frequency coordination, radio programming, and repeater operation in the early 2000s, and finally jumped into amateur radio in 2020.

2026 Amateur Radio Examinations

In the Rogue Valley, amateur radio exams are provided by the RVARC and the SOARC. New exam participants need to provide identification, while upgrading amateurs need to **provide a copy of their current license** as well as show photo identification. **Applicants also need a Federal Registration Number (FRN) and email prior to taking the test.** The exam fee for 2024 remains \$15.00. All license candidates must provide a picture ID. Upgrading amateurs must also provide a photocopy of their current license to send in with their application.
